Unheard Voices: Fighting for My Life examines the criminalization of women who defended themselves against abuse and were later incarcerated. The pilot episode centers on Tyesha Long, whose case raises larger questions about domestic violence, coercive control, trauma, and how survival is often misunderstood within the justice system.

Award-winning filmmaker, journalist, bestselling author, and U.S. Navy veteran Dr. Tamecca Rogers serves as Executive Producer and on-screen narrator. The series creates space for truth, accountability, healing, and awareness — centering voices too often reduced to headlines and case files.

The project arrives at a moment when Oklahoma continues to rank among the highest states in the nation for women's incarceration and among the top states for women killed by men.

Award-Winning Filmmaker Dr. Tamecca Rogers Launches Website for Unheard Voices: Fighting for My Life Documentary Series

New survivor-centered platform highlights documentary production, community impact events, and awareness surrounding domestic violence and incarceration in Oklahoma.

Tulsa, Oklahoma — Award-winning filmmaker, journalist, bestselling author, and U.S. Navy veteran Dr. Tamecca Rogers has officially launched the website for her upcoming documentary series, *Unheard Voices: Fighting for My Life*. The platform serves as the central hub for documentary updates, community impact events, survivor-centered resources, and production news surrounding the powerful investigative series.

Unheard Voices: Fighting for My Life examines the criminalization of women who defended themselves against abuse and were later incarcerated. The pilot episode centers on Tyesha Long, whose case raises larger questions about domestic violence, coercive control, trauma, and how survival is often misunderstood within the justice system.

The website introduces audiences to the vision behind the documentary while also creating space for meaningful community engagement through screenings, awareness events, survivor-centered conversations, and fundraising activations tied to the Unheard Voices Impact Series.

The project comes at a time when Oklahoma continues to rank among the highest states in the nation for women's incarceration and remains among the top states for women killed by men. According to national research, women who have experienced non-fatal strangulation by an abusive partner are more than 700% more likely to later be killed by that abuser.

“This project is about more than one story,” said Dr. Tamecca Rogers, Executive Producer and on-screen narrator of the series. “It’s about creating space for truth, accountability, healing, and awareness while centering the voices of women whose experiences have too often been reduced to headlines and case files.”

The newly launched website features information about the documentary team, production updates, impact events, and opportunities for supporters, advocates, organizations, and community members to get involved.

Upcoming impact events connected to the documentary include spoken word experiences, awareness walks, live music events, women-centered comedy showcases, survivor empowerment experiences, and community fundraising initiatives designed to amplify awareness and support survivor-centered advocacy.

The documentary is currently in production with interviews actively being filmed throughout Oklahoma.

Through Inspire Expressions Media, she develops investigative documentary projects, books, and community-impact programming designed to advance survivor-centered justice.

PRODUCTION

Production is underway across Oklahoma, with interviews actively being filmed for the pilot and subsequent episodes. The series is being produced in partnership with survivor-led organizations and policy advocates aligned with the Oklahoma Survivors' Act.

The Unheard Voices Impact Series extends the documentary's reach through spoken word experiences, awareness walks, live music events, women-centered comedy showcases, survivor empowerment gatherings, and community fundraising initiatives.
